

OKC's Isola Bella Apartments celebrates grand opening, announces new community partner

Isola Bella Apartments, a renovated, gated community in northwest Oklahoma City, celebrated the completion of a \$32 dollar property renovation July 15 with a ribbon-cutting ceremony.

Mayor Mick Cornett, Greater Oklahoma City Chamber of Commerce ambassadors and representatives from the Oklahoma City Convention and Visitors Bureau cut the ceremonial ribbon at the complex, 6446 N. Peniel Ave.

Joe Mansour, principal of property developer Accord Interests, LLC, announced the property's new sponsorship of the Oklahoma City chapter of Big Brothers Big Sisters of Oklahoma during the ceremony as part of the company's community-building initiative.

"We are committed to giving back to the communities where we do business," Mansour said. "The opportunity to provide facilities and host events for an organization that develops strong leaders is something we are thrilled to support."

Accord Interests purchased the property in 2007 and undertook a complete transformation of the Isola Bella Apartments, including the addition of energy-efficient doors and windows, remodeled kitchens and baths and new appliances, roofs, interiors and electrical for the property's 800 units and renovation of the 30,000-square-foot Fitness Center complete with indoor pool, tennis court and basketball court.
